

2016-17 SATs Results and Phonics Screening

Phonics Screening Results

Year 1, 17 in cohort, 1 pupil = 5.8%

100% of Year 1 children screened in June 2017 met or exceeded the expected standard.

Key Stage 1 Results

Year 2, 9 in cohort, 1 pupil = 11.1%

Year 6, 14 in cohort, 1 pupil = 7.1%

In 2017, a school will be above the floor if:

- At least 65% of pupils meet the expected standard in English Reading, English Writing and Mathematics; or
- The school achieves sufficient progress scores in all three subjects. At least -5 in English reading, -5 in Mathematics and -7 in English Writing.

The Bawburgh School will be above the floor as the both criteria have been achieved.
