Universal Free School Meals School Lunches - Your Entitlement Pupils moving into Year 3 in September will no longer be eligible for the Universal School Meal Programme (UFSM). Under the current government scheme, these are only available to Reception and Years 1 and 2.

If you are a parent of a Year 3, 4, 5 or 6 child and are on a low income, you may be entitled to Free School Meals (FSM). I would like to reassure parents that any information regarding FSM is confidential. Please check the attached sheet to see if you are eligible.

For those not eligible for UFSM or FSM, School lunches are available at £2.20 a day. Payment should be sent in on a Monday for the week ahead. Drinks, at 40p, can be purchased by the children at mealtimes.
