**Free School Meals** You may qualify for free school meals for your child/ren if you receive one of the following support payments: Income support; Income-related Employment and Support Allowance; Income based Jobseekers Allowance; Support from NASS; the guarantee element of State Pension Credit; Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190; Working Tax Credit run-on or Universal Credit. Please see Mrs Watton on reception for a Free School Meals application form if you are eligible.
