**This week in Enterprise** Enterprise has been an interesting class this week, with new children coming into the class during our transition taster sessions. It has been an exciting time with children working really hard to adapt. This week has also seen the existing Enterprise class work on their creation stories, which have been varied and fascinating. The pupils have also been sharpening their technical and creative skills through making their own short films on the Ipad's, with impressive results.

**Whole School Trip** We have our fingers crossed it won't rain and too much sun brings the risk of sunburn and dehydration. Please ensure your child is suitably dressed for the weather; a sunhat is vital. Sunscreen should be applied prior to coming to school and should be sent in for application during the day. If the day is really warm then extra drinks are imperative. If rain is forecast then please send a waterproof as well. Also, if your child is having a school packed lunch, please remember to provide a lunch box and bag/rucksack. The children will all be carrying their own lunch, sunscreen etc. and we recommend a small rucksack rather than a plastic bag as this will get very sticky if it is warm.

Further to this, they were constantly challenged in terms of the physical demands of the activities and the levels of independence required.
