Advance Notice - Universal Free School Meals - Your Entitlement Pupils moving into Year 3 in September will no longer be eligible for the Universal School Meal Programme (UFSM). Under the current government scheme, these are only available to Reception and Years 1 and 2.

If you are a parent of a Year 3, 4, 5 or 6 child and are on a low income, you may be entitled to Free School Meals (FSM). I would like to reassure parents that any information regarding FSM is confidential. Please check the attached sheet to see if you are eligible.

For those not eligible for UFSM or FSM, School lunches are available at £2.20 a day. Drinks, at 40p, can be purchased by the children at mealtimes.

Clive is passionate about providing every child with a healthy and nutritious diet and goes to inordinate lengths to ensure this is the case. Please make contact if your child has any special dietary needs. He will always adapt hot lunches/school packed lunches to cater for these, so you can be assured your child's needs are met.
