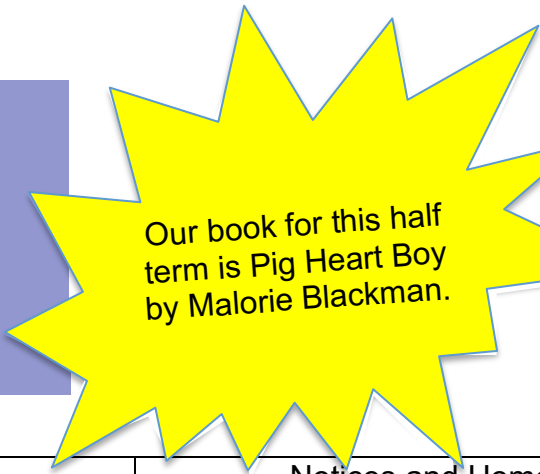




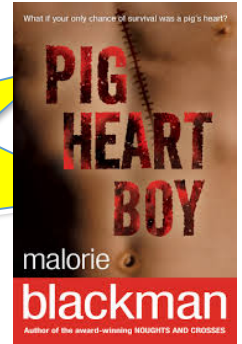

<p><u>English</u> We have been exploring dilemmas faced by the main character's in the book, through drama and role play. We have been identifying the features of news paper articles in preparation for writing our own next week.</p>  <p><u>Spellings</u> To understand how the prefixes re, un, dis, mis, pre, change the meaning of a root word.</p>  <p><u>Maths</u> We have been consolidating written methods for addition of whole numbers and decimals.</p> <p><u>Topic</u> In Science, the children have been learning about the gestation period of animals and in Geography they have been identifying the links they have to countries in North and South America.</p>	<p><u>English</u> The children will be planning and writing their own newspapers reports. The children will be learning to use a range of sentence types to engage the reader and powerful vocabulary.</p> <p><u>Spellings</u> The children will be learning spellings from the year 5/6 spelling list.</p> <p><u>Maths</u> The children will be subtracting numbers mentally with increasingly large numbers. We will then move on to subtracting whole numbers with more than 4 digits, including using formal written methods</p> <p><u>Topic</u> In History, the children will be learning about Maya writing and where they lived. In Science, children will be learning about how our bodies change when we grow. In Geography, the children will be comparing the landscapes of regions in North and South America with our local area.</p>	<p><u>Homework</u> Children will be given a weekly spelling test. Please encourage your children to practise these at home.</p> <p>Children must also continue to read so they can be working towards their targets on Accelerated Reader.</p> <p><u>P.E</u> We have had had make some further changes to the timetable, therefore PE will now be taught on a Tuesday afternoon and first lesson on a Wednesday.</p> <p><u>Head Boy and Girl</u> Miss Stedman is in the process of appointing a Head Boy and Head Girl.
