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This week we have been learning...

Maths:

- We have continued to add and subtract numbers introducing money recognition
- We have been solving problems, reasoning and developing fluency links in place value with the above.

Literacy:

- We have concentrated on looking at punctuation and capital letters and full stops in our writing being careful only to use capital letters and full stops where they are required.
- We have developed our writing skills thinking about character profiles.
- We have developed our understanding of features of fairy stories.

Science:

- We have begun to think about our new topic of plants and about what we know already with regards to the season of winter and made comparisons between the seasons of Summer and Winter.

Speaking and Listening:

- We have worked hard practising our Christmas performance understanding where and when we need to say our words and sing the songs. Please continue to practise learning your words and songs at home.

Phonics: Consolidating our knowledge of long vowel sounds new and old and understanding that when two or more letters go walking the first does the talking!

Maths: Continue to work on addition and subtraction and the relationship between the two with the addition of money and coins.

Science: exploring what happens in observation to plants if all their needs are not met.
