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This week we have been learning...

Maths:

- We have continued to add and subtract numbers using pictorial representations such as part, part whole models and bar models to help us work out our calculations.
- We have been solving problems, reasoning and developing fluency links in place value.

Literacy:

- We have concentrated on looking at punctuation and finger spaces in our writing being careful only to use capital letters and full stops where they are required.
- As part of Anti- Bullying Week we have carried out literacy exercises that have enabled us to consolidate some of our literacy skills in another area.
- We have been writing blurbs for our story and editing these before using ICT to complete our finished blurb.

Science:

- We have begun to think about our new topic of plants and about what we know already with regards to the season of winter.

Religious Education:

- We have spent time thinking about light as our overall theme in RE and celebrated the story of Rama and Sita by making our own diva lamps using different materials and being creative.

What we are looking forward to next week:

Phonics: Developing our knowledge of long vowel sounds and understanding that when two or more letters go walking the first does the talking!

Maths: Continue to work on addition and subtraction and the relationship between the two. We also will be looking at counting in different steps of 2.

Science: exploring what happens to plants if all their needs are not met.

Art and DT: What happens to colour when we add white or black?
