A key aspect has been our understanding of what happens when we times or divide by 10. We have discovered that you don't simply add or deduct a zero, but actually move the number into a new place value. I.E. $10 \times 12 = 120$ or $140 \div 10 = 14$. This is a crucial piece of mathematical knowledge. With this we were able to solve far more complex problems. We have also been looking at Prime and Factor numbers.

Of course a big event last week was our trip to London and The Natural History Museum. May I stress just how proud we were of the class. Their behaviour on the long trip there and back again was excellent and they were a great advert to Bawburgh when we roamed the vast displays. We managed to see the dinosaurs, mammals, fish, amphibians and the rock, earthquake and volcano section, plus held a science investigation which formed our focus for literacy.



We had a second class trip this week which took us to Norwich Mosque and Norwich Cathedral. It was a fascinating day where we learnt about different faiths and their rituals.
