

<p><u>English</u> The children have been writing in role as Maia in the form of a travel journal. They have been using fronted adverbials for cohesion and the use of the semi-colon to add detail to their descriptive writing.</p> <p><u>Spellings</u> Our spelling focus this week has been words ending in -ent/-ence/ency</p> <p><u>Maths</u> We have been learning about different mental methods of division. The children learnt what dividing by equal multiples meant and what dividing by un equal multiples meant. The children also used their place value knowledge to divide by 10, 100 and 1000. We moved onto written methods and looked at division through sharing.</p> <p><u>Anti Bullying Week</u> This week has been anti bullying week and children have been looking at lots of different ways to support each other and be kind.</p>	<p><u>English</u> The children learning about the features of non-chronological reports and completing their own research. They will be learning how to use generalisers in their writing and the difference between the active and passive voice.</p> <p><u>Spellings</u> We will be learning to spell words when the 'c' makes a 's' sound before i, e and y.</p> <p><u>Maths</u> In Maths we will continue to look at division and will be moving onto more formal methods of division. We will learn why the 'bus stop' method is not really a 'bus stop' at all but instead a form of array.</p> <p><u>Topic</u> In French next week we will be learning how to greet people, talk about family, say what people have and have not in the third person and describe people in the third person.</p>	<p><u>Homework</u> Please encourage your children to practise their weekly spellings ready for their test on Monday.</p> <p>Children to complete English homework on fronted adverbials, to be handed in on Friday.</p> <p>Children must also continue to read so they can be working towards their targets on Accelerated Reader. The children now know their point targets for Bronze award and some children have already achieved these!</p> <p>Please could the children start to think of different games that we could do at the school christmas fair.
