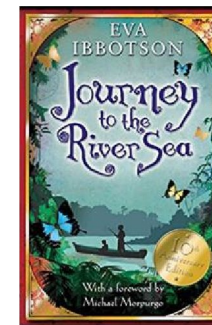

<p><u>English</u> This week the children have been writing their non-chronological reports and learning the difference between the passive and active voice.</p> <p><u>Spellings</u> The children have been learning to spell words with unstressed vowels and unstressed consonants.</p> <p><u>Maths</u> We have continued to work on division and have progressed on to the long method of division.</p> <p><u>Topic</u> The children have applied the skills they have developed in English to write an engaging recount about our trip to the Natural History Museum. In Science, the children will begin to plan a non-chronological report about the digestive system. They will also return to their recounts about the trip to the Natural History Museum in order to make their final edits.</p>	<p><u>Homework</u> Please encourage your children to practise their weekly spellings ready for their test on Monday.</p> <p>Children must also continue to read so they can be working towards their targets on Accelerated Reader.
