

<p><u>English</u> We have started our new book, 'The Highwayman' By Alfred Noyes. We will be looking at figurative language, for example similies, metaphors and personification.</p> <p><u>Spellings</u> To spell words with double consonants. <i>accommodate, accompany, according, aggressive, apparent, appreciate, attached, committee, communicate, community, correspond, immediate, occupy, opportunity, recommend, suggest</i></p>  <p><u>Maths</u> We have been looking at addition and subtraction of both proper and impropoer fractions this week. The children have used concrete resources to help them model and understand how to use fractions with different denominators.</p> <p><u>Topic</u> This week in History we started our new topic of Crime and Punishment through the ages.
