## This week we have been learning...

### Maths:

- \* We have been looking at how arrays can help us create 2 multiplication facts.
- \* We have begun to look at multiplication and division fact families
- \* We have been counting in 2s, 5s and 10's

### Literacy:

- \* We have been thinking about how to create two different or contrasting settings
- \* Our focus has been on writing short, well-structured sentences which we can read back and edit.

### Science:

- \* We have thought about flexibility in materials and have learnt that even strong structures can be flexible.
- \* We have worked collaboratively to carry out an investigation into bendy objects in our classroom. We are now working on how to write up a simple scientific investigation.
