<p><u>English</u> The children have been planning and writing a persuasive letter to a close friend. They will need to plan the piece of writing in order to ensure they include the grammatical features appropriate to the form they choose.</p> <p><u>Spellings</u> The children will be learning to spell words from the statutory year 5/6 spelling list.</p> <p><u>Maths</u> The children will be looking at measuring and classifying angles of different shapes.</p> <p><u>Topic</u> We will be looking at and researching a country in Europe that they have had to travel through in their previous task. In Science, the children will be designing their own burglar alarms.</p>	<p><u>Homework</u> Children will be given a weekly spelling test. Please encourage your children to practise these at home. Children must also continue to read so they can be working towards their targets on Accelerated Reader.</p> <p>Maths Homework</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Homework will be given out on a Friday and will reinforce the work completed in class. The children will have a week to complete their homework which will be self/peer marked in school on a Friday. Could books please be in school on a Wednesday in order for myself and Mrs Wilson to check them. <p>This week's homework; Year 5 - 10 revise rounding numbers. Year 6 - 42 & 43 missing number problems. If children are finding any areas of their homework they must tell either myself or Mrs Wilson and we will give them some extra help in school.</p>
