Last week we were learning...

Maths:

* to recognise equal and unequal groups. We thought about how we can use repeated addition to label equal groups and what the related multiplication statement would be.

* to share into equal groups. We took a larger number of objects to see if we could share them into equal groups and how we can write that as a division.

Literacy:

* to write a fictional narrative about a giant.

* to write sequentially with a clear beginning, middle and end.

Science:

* study the trees and plants around us and observe changes. We recorded our observations and will compare the same trees and plants over the next few weeks.

History: * to act out the daring rescue of nine survivors by Grace Darling and her father. We thought about the correct sequence of events and started to record them in our books.

Next week we will be learning...

Literacy: how to use the present tense to write instructions

Phonics: Year 1 focus: are / y / ph
Year 2 focus: when the vowel sound changes after 'w'

Maths: to recognise the link between multiplication and division

Science: Learning walk and observations on changes in plants and trees

History: about coastal life and how it might be different to modern times.
