Sports Day was a great success this year, the children thoroughly enjoyed themselves. We wanted to try something new this year with Sports Day and for the children to experience a full day of sports activities. In the morning the children were split into 12 groups each led by an adult in school (3 teams per house). They rotated around 12 different activities collecting valuable points for their houses. The children showed great skills in throwing a javelin, following assault courses, triple jump etc. The older children in all of the groups were fabulous at demonstrating the activities and supporting their younger team mates. There was a real sense of house team spirit which supports our school values. Thank you to those of you who were able to come to the picnic lunch and stay for the afternoon races, the children loved eating with you! The children had pre-selected which race they would like to take part in, this included; egg and spoon, three-legged race, sack race and the 100m sprint.
