Last week we were learning...

Maths: what multiplication means. We looked at equal and unequal groups and we counted how many 'lots of' we had. We talked about how 'lots of' means times.

Literacy: We have been looking at poetry and thinking about rhythm and rhyme. We have been finding lots of rhyming words and writing a class poem together.

Science: We have been looking at growth and survival of animals including humans. We talked about how some animals give birth to live young and others lay eggs.

Geography: we have been discussing the seas around Britain and comparing them to the seas in warmer parts of the world.

We are also using globes to find key features like the pole, the equator and continents.



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## Next week we will be learning...

Maths: we will be looking at multiplication and commutativity and how that can help us to solve problems.

Literacy: We will continue our work on poetry.

Science: we will be looking at how we grow as we get older. We will be measuring our height and feet.

Geography: Continuing our work on identifying the continents and oceans on a globe.
