Last week we were learning...

Maths: We have been looking at addition of two 2-digit numbers. We have been using base ten to group our tens and ones and thinking about how to show these additions on a number line.

We have also been looking for related facts in addition. Eg. If 4 + 6 = 10 then I know that 14 + 6 = 20.

Literacy: We have started a new theme this half term based around the book Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers. We have been exploring how the boy and the penguin feel and writing speech bubbles to go with the pictures.

Science: We went on another learning walk to see what was the same and what was different about the plants and the trees since our last walk 6 weeks ago.

Geography: we discussed our new topic and did an exploration task on how much we already knew about the world's continents and oceans as well as the countries that make up the UK.



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Next week we will be learning...

Maths: we will be finishing our unit on addition and subtraction and moving on to money and the value of coins

Literacy: We will thinking about the sequence of events in Lost and Found and how we might like to make our own additions or improvements.

Science: we will be investigating how the shape of some materials changes when we manipulate them

Geography: we will be studying globes and atlases to investigate oceans and continents
