Period Product Scheme The Government have introduced a scheme for all learners who need to access period products in their place of learning. We will be signing up for the scheme and as part of our responsibilities we will be speaking to pupils in Years 4, 5 and 6 (age appropriate conversations) and providing safety and usage information. They DO NOT accept: Duvets and blankets, pillows and cushions, carpets, rugs and mats (including bath, shower and toilet mats), soiled, painted, ripped or wet clothing, School uniforms with and without logo, corporate clothing and workwear, textile off cuts, yarns or threaded material. They will be collecting on Thursday 30th January at 9 a.m.
