Last week we were learning ...

Maths: how to find fractions of numbers. What is a quarter of 8? What is half of 6?

Líteracy: We have been extending our work on Emma Jane's aeroplane by writing our own adventure story. Grammar focus on suffixes, adverbs, adjectives.

Science: we looked at the food pyramid and identified which foods we should eat most/least of. We thought about how to plan a healthy menu for a day.

Hístory: we studíed the Wríght brothers in more depth, planning a diary entry which explains how they feel about their work.

Maths: we will finish our work on fractions and start with statistics: tally, pictogram etc
