

<p><u>English</u> The children have been creating their own radio adverts to practise using persuasive devices. They have been planning to write their own leaflets and refining their note taking skills.</p> <p><u>Spellings</u> The children have been learning to convert nouns or adjectives into verbs using the suffix -ise.</p>  <p><u>Maths</u> The children have been revising place value in decimal numbers and being able to multiply/divide by 10/100/1000. They have also been using pictorial representations to show how they add/subtract/multiply decimals with up to 3 places.</p> <p><u>Science</u> The children have planned and carried out an experiment where they have been investigating the effects of friction.</p>	<p><u>English</u> The children will be planning and writing their own leaflets to advertise Infinity Park. In grammar will continue to look at using a range of punctuation including, colons, semicolons and bullet points.
