



Addendum to School Behaviour Policy for Covid-19 Safety Precautions

Children will be expected to follow the school safety procedures in relation to Covid-19 as appropriate, our hygiene expectations have been made clear in our Bawburgh School Special Code of Conduct document. If a child fails to follow the procedures as made clear to them and as a result compromises their own safety or the safety of others, sanctions will apply in accordance with the school's positive discipline and behaviour policy.

Behaviours we expect to see are:

- Following altered routines for arrival or departure.
- Following school instructions on hygiene.
- Following instructions on how pupils can socialise within school.
- Moving around the school as per specific instructions.
- Taking responsibility for using tissues to catch coughs and sneezes and disposing of them in the lidded bin provided.
- Following rules about sharing any equipment.
- Following amended expectations about break and lunch times, including where children may or may not play.
- Following the rules about access to toilets.
- Following rules about coughing or spitting at or towards any other person.

Individual Pupils and Risk Assessments

Every effort will be made to cater for the needs of children in our school family. In some cases it may be necessary to complete a risk assessment for individual pupils. The risk assessments will focus on individual needs and will be completed in consultation with parents and regularly reviewed.

For a small number of pupils, there may be behaviours identified in risk assessments which can be safely managed through restrictive physical intervention (RPI) to avoid foreseeable and actual harm to themselves and others. Any staff members involved in RPI will have received the appropriate training from Norfolk Steps.
