Remote Learning Our Plan B for remote learning in the event of an individual isolating, a bubble closure, or full lockdown was officially signed off last night at the Governors meeting. The plan and an example timetable will be uploaded to the website next week. We used the responses from the parent survey (we had 84 responses - thank you!) and the government guidance to help us.

Over the coming week, teachers will be sending home a 'stationary pack' this will contain an exercise book, pencil and age appropriate work. This is not homework. Please keep this pack safe until you need it. It is likely that we will have very little notice if a child has to isolate, a bubble has to close or we are put into a local lockdown, the stationary pack is there for the child to use on day 1 of remote learning, this will enable the teacher time to plan activities that are inline with what your child is learning in class at that point in time.

Your teacher will produce a weekly plan, each day will have four planned activities and this will be uploaded to Class DoJo or Tapestry. Your teacher will also post daily the activities they would like the child to complete. We will be using a combination of, the Government funded and recommended Oak National Academy, Timestables Rockstars, Numbots, Spelling Shed, Accelerated Reader and Letters and Sounds videos to support your child's learning. There will be an expectation that on average, 2 pieces of work will be returned (via DoJo or Tapestry) to the teacher on a daily basis for marking and feedback. Your teacher will lead 3 sessions a week with the children via Zoom so they will have regular visual contact as well as daily comments via DoJo or Tapestry.

I hope that we do not need to put this plan into action, but it is there in case we do! We will obviously do all we can to make the transition between school and home learning as seamless and as supported as possible. If you have any questions regarding Plan B, please ask your teacher or you can find me on the playground most mornings.
