New Covid 19 email address if you have a positive test result please email covid@bawburgh.norfolk.sch.uk at any time to let us know. It is important that you use this email address so that we are able act promptly. This email will be checked during and out of school hours.

A reminder, if anyone living in your family home (adult or child) has to take a Covid-19 test due to displaying one of the three symptoms, **everyone** needs to stay at home and isolate until you receive the test results. It is not OK to send your child into school if you know someone else living in your family home has taken a test and are awaiting results.

Covid-19 Precautions in school next week We will be tightening our procedures next week so that hopefully we can all have a happy Christmas without the need for anyone to isolate. As a result I would like to ask the following:

- The EYFS and KS1 bubble will not be functioning as one bubble instead they will be two, so please when you drop and collect your child could, Flamingos children line up near their fence, Kingfishers could they line up where Mrs Ellis normally collects them. Any family with children in both bubbles can you stand in 'neutral territory' (middle ground between the 2 lines) until the children can go into class.
- Please encourage Flamingos and Kingfishers children from running around on the playground with each other.
- If you need to speak to the office please ring or email, do not come into school.

In school we will be doing the following:

- All 4 bubbles will be kept separate at breakfast club, break time, lunch time and after school club.
- Adults will, as far as possible, not enter other bubbles. However, Mrs Holgate will continue to do PPA cover in classes, but she is never in two classes on one day.
- Visitors will not be allowed in school next week.
