Covid 19 email address if you have a positive test result please email covid@bawburgh.norfolk.sch.uk at any time to let us know. It is important that you use this email address so that we are able act promptly. This email will be checked during and out of school hours.

A reminder, if anyone living in your family home (adult or child) has to take a Covid-19 (PCR) test due to displaying one of the three symptoms, **everyone** needs to stay at home and isolate until you receive the test results.

It is not OK to send your child into school if you know someone living in your family home has taken a test and are awaiting results.

Covid-19 precautions in school following the most recent update to the NCC risk assessment after the Government's announcement on the 17th May, I wanted to let you know that our procedures in school remain unchanged.

It is important for us not to become complacent, although many of us have now had at least one dose of the Covid-19 vaccine we still need to stay at home, isolate and book a PCR test (do not use an LFD test) if you or anyone in your family has any of the three symptoms - persistent cough, temperature over 37.8 degrees or a loss of taste and/or smell. Please do not send your child/ren to school if anybody in your family home has had a test and is awaiting test results.

We need to protect ourselves and each other, thank you.

Coats Staff have expressed concerns that many children do not have coats in school. Your child may protest they do not need a coat however; they will be outside in all but the most inclement weather so it is important they have one in school every day.

Drop off for Hummingbird children Unfortunately, there are a number of Hummingbirds children who are being dropped off before 9.00 am and being left unsupervised on the playground. This message has been on the bulletin a number of times and your class teachers have sent it via Class Dojo. To ensure the safety of the children, we will be locking the gate after Flamingos have entered and will re-open it at 8.55 am. We are sorry if this causes any inconvenience but the safety of the children is paramount. Don't forget that we have our Breakfast Club which starts at either 7.30 am (bookable through ParentMail £5.00 per day) or early drop off at 8.45 am (£2.00 no need to prebook).
