Covid 19 email address if you have a positive test result please email covid@bawburgh.norfolk.sch.uk at any time to let us know. It is important that you use this email address so that we are able act promptly. This email will be checked during and out of school hours.

A reminder, if anyone living in your family home (adult or child) has to take a Covid-19 (PCR) test due to displaying one of the three symptoms, **everyone** needs to stay at home and isolate until you receive the test results.

It is not OK to send your child into school if you know someone living in your family home has taken a test and are awaiting results.

If your child develops symptoms and subsequently receives a positive test within 48 hours of attending school (before 3.15pm, 3.30pm or if in afterschool club later on Sunday 30th May) please let the school know by contacting the covid@ email address as we will need to inform families to isolate. If your child has a positive test result from Monday 31st May onwards please inform NHS test and trace. Thank you

Covid-19 precautions in school following the most recent update to the NCC risk assessment after the Government's announcement on the 17th May, I wanted to let you know that our procedures in school remain unchanged.

It is important for us not to become complacent, although many of us have now had at least one dose of the Covid-19 vaccine we still need to stay at home, isolate and book a PCR test (do not use an LFD test) if you or anyone in your family has any of the three symptoms - persistent cough, temperature over 37.8 degrees or a loss of taste and/or smell. Please do not send your child/ren to school if anybody in your family home has had a test and is awaiting test results.

We need to protect ourselves and each other, thank you.
