First Week Back Welcome back to the start of a new academic year. Bikeability Year 5 This will take place in school on 14th and 15th September. Please remember to bring your child's bike into school together with their cycle helmet. You will need to ensure that the bike is roadworthy with two working brakes.

Inhalers Children with asthma should have inhalers in school at all times. If your child has asthma, a new asthma record form will need to be completed. Parents of Year 3 and 4 children - Your child will need to take their inhaler to swimming lessons each week as chlorine in a swimming pool can close nasal passages slightly and make breathing more difficult. Please return the Asthma Record (care plan) form asap so we can update our records.

Covid 19 email address If your child is displaying any symptoms of Covid-19 (it only has to be one symptom not all three) please keep them at home and take them for a PCR test, they will need to stay at home until a negative test result is received. Please let the school office know as soon as possible using the covid@bawburgh.norfolk.sch.uk as we will need to notify close contacts and ask them to take a PCR test.

Universal Free School Meals - Your Entitlement Pupils who have moved into Year 3 in September will no longer be eligible for the Universal School Meal Programme (UFSM). Under the current government scheme, these are only available to Reception and Years 1 and 2.

If you are a parent of a Year 3, 4, 5 or 6 child and are on a low income, you may be entitled to Free School Meals (FSM). Please speak to the Office.
