Inhalers Children with asthma should have inhalers in school at all times. If your child has asthma, a new asthma record form will need to be completed. Parents of Year 3 and 4 children - Your child will need to take their inhaler to swimming lessons each week as chlorine in a swimming pool can close nasal passages slightly and make breathing more difficult. Please return the Asthma Record (care plan) form asap so we can update our records.

Covid 19 email address If your child is displaying any symptoms of Covid-19 (it only has to be one symptom not all three) please keep them at home and take them for a PCR test, they will need to stay at home until a negative test result is received. Please let the school office know as soon as possible using the covid@bawburgh.norfolk.sch.uk as we will need to notify close contacts and ask them to take a PCR test.
