Covid Cases week ending 14<sup>th</sup> January 2022

We have had 2 reported positive cases this week.

**Covid-19** You will have heard on the news that guidance around isolation periods has changed again! Below details the guidance from Monday:

## **Isolation** Periods

'From Monday 17 January, people who are self-isolating with COVID-19 will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with a lateral flow device (LFD) test on both day 5 and day 6 and they do not have a temperature. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to their education or childcare setting immediately on day 6.

The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. All test results should be reported to NHS Test and Trace. If the result of either of their tests is positive, they should continue to self-isolate until they get negative results from two LFD tests on consecutive days or until they have completed 10 full days of self-isolation, whichever is earliest.

Anyone who is unable to take LFD tests or anyone who continues to have a temperature will need to complete the full 10 day period of self-isolation.

Further information on self-isolation for those with COVID-19 is available.' (Information taken from the Department for Education on 14/1/21)

If you receive a positive LFD or PCR test please continue to let the school know, via the email <u>covid@bawburgh.norfolk.sch.uk</u>

If your child is displaying any of the Covid-19 symptoms (it only has to be one) please keep them at home and book a PCR test. Please stay at home and isolate until you receive the results, if negative, and well enough to be in school they can return, if positive please remain at home and isolate 5-10 days (see above guidance on isolation).
