Covid-19 Although the national guidance has changed, the advice from Norfolk County Council states that we should now start to treat Covid-19 infections like any other public health concern we face in schools, e.g with chickenpox your child is not allowed into school until the spots are scabbed over, Norovirus/tummy bugs, your child is not allowed back into school until they are 48 hours clear. With Covid-19 infections, your child will need to stay at home and isolate for at least 5 full days and then continue to follow the guidance until they have received 2 negative test results on consecutive days. If they are still testing positive by day 10 they are allowed back into school on day 11.

'Routine national and local contact tracing will end and reliance will be placed upon positive cases making their relevant contacts aware. Contacts will no longer be required to self-isolate or take daily tests, although while asymptomatic kits are still freely available testing is advisable and guidance to take extra care to keep others safe will remain.'
