Do we know who is picking up your child? Parents are reminded that, in line with Child Protection and Safeguarding best practice, school should be notified if someone else is picking up your child from school. Notification can be made by letter, e mail or phone. If someone else is to pick up regularly then it is not necessary to notify us on every occasion; a written communication along the lines of, 'Every Wednesday, Mrs X will pick up my son Y' is perfectly acceptable. Likewise, if your child is walking home (children in Year 5 and 6 only), we need a written communication giving your consent.
