Rule 5 - No squash in water bottles * still no Fizzy in water bottle, but any flavour squash is okay!*

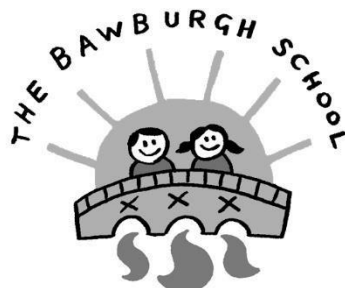
Rule 6 - No pyjamas * wear your most comfortable pyjamas*
