Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to extend a warm welcome to you and your family as we become partners in your child/children's education. It seems as if the weeks are flying by and in no time the summer holidays will be upon us.

Originally, we had tentative plans for a Zoom session to be held on the 11<sup>th</sup> June 2021. Unfortunately, this date had to be cancelled due to the resignation of our current EYFS teacher, Mrs Sharpe. However, I can confirm, before half term, following a rigorous interview process, we recruited Mrs Maddy Dring. Mrs Dring has worked this academic year alongside Mrs Sharpe in Flamingos whilst completing her Initial Teacher Training with the Suffolk and Norfolk SCITT, she also brings a wealth of experience and knowledge with her from her previous job at a school in Dereham. We are very excited to welcome her to our school.

We would like to invite you, **one parent and child/children** (no younger siblings please) to a **transition morning on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> July** on the following basis:

- Arrive with parent at **9.30am – 11.45am** where activities and a story session will be carried out by Mrs Dring and the class teaching assistant – Mrs Tuma. If you come to Playground gate, you will be greeted by Mrs Duffy who will sign you in and direct you to the Flamingos class entrance.
- **11.45 am-12.45pm** the children will be invited to eat together at a Teddy Bear's picnic. Food will be **provided for the children** and if adults wish to eat with their child then please bring a packed lunch. Please also bring a small teddy bear.
- Please ensure that adults wear a mask at all times and adhere to social distancing rules from other adults at 2m.
- Children and parents will be asked to leave at **12.45pm**.
- Mrs Dring will be circulating and offering 1-1 zoom sessions to parents to be held after the transition morning as part of the meet and greet process and to discuss any concerns and questions you may have on a 1-1 basis. She will have a timed schedule available for you to complete.
- Mrs Dring will also, prior to this date, ring your child's nursery school for an update on their progress.
